

## GU3A EXCURSION TO THE YORK MYSTERY PLAYS

Tuesday, August 14th 2012

The coach will leave Fountain Street car park at 13.30 and then pick up outside St Paulinus School. Tickets will be distributed and we will travel directly to York.

There will be time to look around the city and have a meal prior to the performance, which commences at 19.30. We have numbered seats in the middle of Block B, directly facing the stage, in a covered theatre built for 1400 people.

Immediately after the performance ends we will be collected by the coach for the return journey to Guisborough. Drop off points will be outside St Paulinus School and Fountain Street.

The tradition of the York Mystery Plays began in the 14<sup>th</sup> century. In 2012 they form part of the celebrations marking the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of York's City Charter. This is a new adaptation of the original 48 plays, which depicted events from the Creation to the Last Judgement. It has been written by Mike Kenny, who adapted The Railway Children for its Olivier Award-winning production at the National Railway Museum. Over 1000 local people will take part – in the grounds of St Mary's Abbey.

The cost of this excursion includes theatre tickets, coach travel, a tip for the driver and 50p per person to GU3A.
